Re: Zoning application E 150

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Permit me to urgently request the Council to deny the application for C2 zoning of the Rental Tool Shop at Capitol View Avenue. The area to be rezoned sits in the curve of an S which is sharp and hilly two ways. There are constant tie-ups and there have been several accidents already.

The applicant is referring to plans for widening and relocation of Capitol View Avenue and I urge the County Council most fervently not to grant this rezoning until such changes have taken place. No funds have been allocated by the State Roads Commission whose plans have been drawn for the next 6 years. An application for C2 zoning may have merit then, but will be a serious hazard and cause hardship if granted now.

Thank you very much for your kind letter. It is really a great pity that Henry and I got never again together since the mid fifties. But I am very much relieved about what you tell me about his last years and the fact that he did not suffer before he died.

I remember somebody told me a decade back that he perished during the war or it elast has never been seen or heard of since, but I do not even know who told me that.
