Empire novations – Gov denied new initiative funding.

Chancellor is arguing. Among new initiatives is about 15mill? In faculty lines; 3.2 in something, 8.2 in nursing, engineering...et c Under "access to an affordable and attainable education" money to help with enrollment growth...in there....

Gov has established a commission on higher ed... to see how we can go from good to great.

Capital budget, not a lot, some for critical maintenance... ccapital project: our #1 project = business/nano project, notin governor's budget. We are going back to legislature onthat.....

Evolving process....
