This morning, we inspected and accepted the Mechanical Equipment room in the basement of the Fine Arts building, subject to punch list. This was advisable, even though the punch list is still of considerable proportion, because we wanted to run the Heating, Ventilating System for the Gallery beginning tomorrow evening and on, into the night hours. Unless the mechanical equipment was in our hands, it would have either precipitated a strike or at least would have necessitated premium payment for the employment of overtime union tradesmen to man this room. This has now been avoided.

We also inspected and accepted the Mall immediately south of the Campus Center. This was in very good shape, and already we are receiving many compliments.

Inspected, but not accepted, was the Great Circle grass plot at the main entrance from Washington Avenue. Although this plot had a reasonably good "take" on the seeding last spring, there are still some bare spots which need corrective work, and inasmuch as we are not hurting for this area, it is to our interest to wait until this corrective work has been accomplished.
