

in laboratory practice. The total cost of the changes and repairs was \$158²⁵. Whereupon the report was accepted and the expenditures approved.

The subject of electing a president in place of Dr. Alton was then considered and (Mr. Waterbury having retired) it was unanimously resolved that Edward F. Waterbury A.M. a graduate of the School in 1849 be chosen President, his service to begin at the close of the present term. The compensation of the president was fixed at \$2500 per annum with the same privilege as to a residue as enjoyed by the present incumbent. Without further action the committee then adjourned.
