Because these courses are designed specifically to fulfill requirements in the student's major, it is very important that the content corresponds very closely to the course descriptors that the faculty groups

Please note that other courses in each discipline can still be accepted in transfer by campus-to-campus agreements and many courses are accepted for general education credit or for graduation credit.

When these lists are finalized, the entire file will be made available to your admissions office so that transcript evaluation for transfer students can be facilitated.
