After conversation on the condition & work of the model school the committee reported to the school. After some time spent principally in conversation adjourned to meet again at the school building at 4 o'clock P.M. and requested Dr. Alden to invite all the teachers to be present.

A full conversation was had with each teacher, especially in regard to the time occupied by each and the subjects of instruction.
