After further conversation it was agreed that all the members of the committee shall visit the school tomorrow morning at ten O'clock.

The committee then adjourned,

The committee met at the call of the Chairman.

Present all the members.

After conversation on the condition & work of the Model School the committee passed to the school. They found the school in an apparently prosperous condition, but in need of more assistance to the Superintendent Mr. Kelly, Miss Bishop who was appointed assistant in that department being occupied most of the time in work in the Normal School. After some time spent principally in conversation adjourned to meet again at the school building about 2 O'clock P.M. and requested Dr. Alden to invite all the teachers to be present.

4 O'clock P.M.

Pursuant to adjournment all the members were present and the Faculty of the school.

A free conversation was had with each teacher, especially in regard to the time occupied by each and the subjects of instruction.

The committee expressed to Dr. Alden their conviction that Miss Bishop ~~should~~ should spend all her time in assisting Mrs. Kelly in the Model School.
