  - Prior Learning Assessment policy will be reviewed at February Board of Trustees meeting
  - Streamlined procedures for academic program review effective October 28, 2022 (Technology solution, Kuali, in development)

- DLE Implementation Updates
  - Cohort 3 and 4 campuses moving toward implementation
  - Survey results from cohort 1 and cohort 2 campuses
  - SUNY is working on governance structure for the LMS and data
  - Data Access: All will be governed by governance framework. Draft has been developed, heavily informed by framework from SUNY's IR office.

# Chancellor Remarks and Sector Comments | SUNY Chancellor | John King

- Chancellor shared his four pillars/core values
  - Student success
  - o Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion: this is everyone's job
  - Research and scholarship
  - o Economic development and upward mobility
- Chancellor heard short presentations and fielded questions from representatives of each sector (University Centers, Campus Governance Leaders, comprehensive colleges, tech and ag, specialized and statutory college, and health sciences)

### <u>United University Professions | UUP President | Fred Kowal</u>

- Positive relationship with governor and executive branch for first time in a decade
- Has spoken with Governor since SotS, reminded her that SUNY is crucial to this year's initaitves
- Have made case that at least 19 campuses are facing significant deficits and that we need funding (\$150-160M) directed to those campuses in order for them to be able to grow, attract students, and be successful
- Favor expanding the money that was put in the budget last year for faculty and staff
- Optimistic about potential to partner with new Chancellor in advocating for resources
- Contract negotiations: down to three big categories
  - Telecommuting
  - Job security (State made demands that would erode job security and tenure)
  - Money
- Believes contract can be done by June
- Health benefits pretty well locked down

## SUNY Student Assembly | SA President | Alexandria Chun

- Championed the creation of four teams within the SA
  - Human resources

- Policy
- Communication
- Student voices
- Working on establishing a student activity fee to fund their work
- Advocacy re: reducing food insecurity, making room and board TAP eligible

### Faculty Council of Community Colleges Report | FCCC President | Christy Woods

- Considering writing a mental health white paper, gather data and use it to talk to system about more funding
- Concerns about mergers, retrenchment
- Concerns about shared governance at the campus level
- Discussion of funding requests

#### <u>CUNY UFS Report | CUNY UFS President | John Verzani</u>

- Updates on transfer, budget, enrollment, remediation phaseout, and concerns raised by faculty at specific campuses
- Update on development of new online programs, aiming for significant growth in this area

### Nominations and Elections Committee | Patrick Doyle

- Introduces members of committee
- Nominations deadline March 8: requires CV and statement of candidacy (1-page limit)
- CGLs can nominate but cannot vote.
