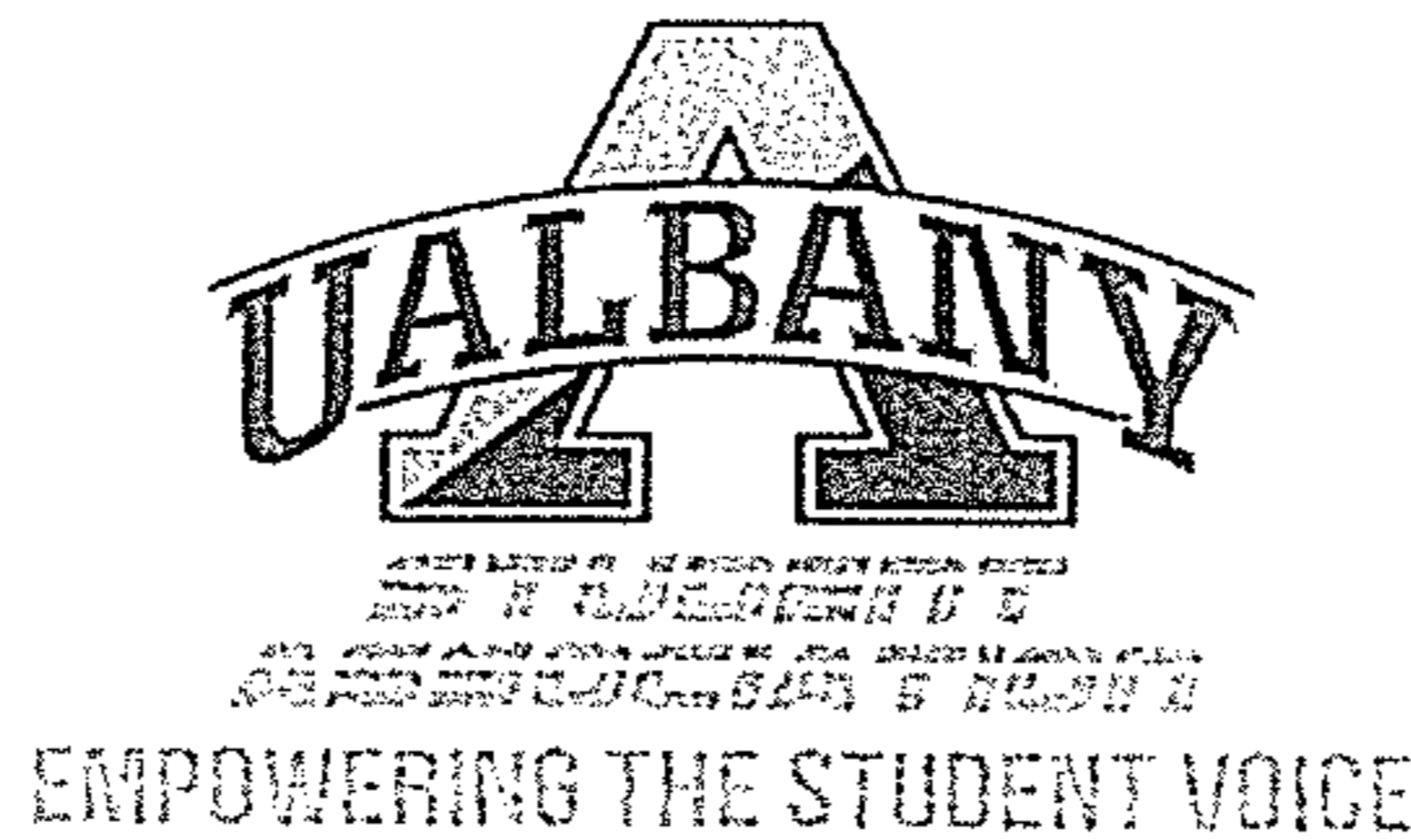

- II. WHEREAS, It is intuitive to respect the identity of all individuals on campus; and
- III. WHEREAS, The practices within the Student Association need to be less heteronormative and more inclusive; and
- IV. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the University at Albany Student Association use the proper gender pronoun of all individuals; and
- V. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the University at Albany Student Association Senate include gender pronouns on name cards, should an individual request it; and
- VI. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the University at Albany Student Association leaders include their gender pronouns on their email; and
- VII. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the University at Albany Student Association leaders increase their effort in representing for and outreaching to the LGBTQIA+ community; and
- VIII. THEREFORE MAY IT BE FINALLY RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be sent to Desann Chin-Carty, President of the Student Association, Nicholas Chin, Chairperson of the Student Association Senate, Shouyue Zhang, Chief Justice of the Student Association Supreme Court, Tanner McCracken, Vice Chairperson of the Student Association Senate, Joseph Vesic, Secretary of the Student Association Senate, and Shannon Beal, Executive Office Manager of the Student Association Senate.
