**Video Showings on Wednesday August 9th at 6:00
to Commemorate 50th Anniversary of Bombing of Nagasaki**

On Wednesday August 9th, the 50th anniversary of the U.S. bombing of Nagasaki, from 6 to 8 pm Peace Offerings will show three videos: Bound by the Wind, on nuclear testing world wide, With Our Own Eyes, a report from a youth delegation to Hiroshima in 1994, and Sadako and the 1000 Cranes, the animated story of a little girl who contracted leukemia as a result of the bombings.

These acclaimed films provide a look at the horrors of nuclear weapons, a sensitive view of the victims of the bombings, and a look at the current threat of nuclear weapons to remind us that we must never let it happen again.
