The Committee came to order in the office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction at the hour appointed.

There were present Supt. Skinner, in the chair, and Messrs. Pruyn and Ward, with Pres. Milne, by invitation.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Pruyn moved that degrees and diplomas be granted to those candidates who have passed satisfactory examinations and are recommended by the Faculty, as shown by the printed list hereto appended. Carried.

Dr. Ward moved, on the recommendation of Dr. Milne that the degree of Doctor of Pedagogy be conferred upon Helen Patterson, Principal of the Girls' High School, at Brooklyn, N. Y.; James A. Fashay, Los Angeles, Cal.; and Carleton M. Ritter, Principal of the Normal School at Chico, Cal. - all of them graduates of this college. Carried.

On motion of Mr. Pruyn it was resolved that the President be instructed to purchase a suitable piano.

On motion of Mr. Pruyn, President Milne was instructed to make arrangements to get repairs made on upper floor of college building, the same to be paid for out of the appropriation for such purposes in the hands of the Superintendent.

On the recommendation of Pres. Nichols, Mr. Ward moved that the following salaries of teachers in the college be increased: that of Miss Amelia Hyde to six hundred dollars, (\$600.); that of Miss Anna E. Stusted to six hundred dollars (\$600.); that Mr. Geo. G. Grant to one thousand dollars (\$1000.); that of Mr. Le. Stuart Gager to one thousand dollars (\$1000.); and that of Mr. Leonard W. Richardson to twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500.). Carried.

Supt. Skinner announced the resignation from this Committee of Mr. Marcus L. Howe which news was received with deep regret by all the remaining members.

On motion adjourned.
