The committee met in Judge Draper's office, at the hour named, present, the judge in the chair, and Messrs. Kim and Ward, with President Milne by invitation.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Judge Draper reported that after receiving bids from six of the most responsible dealers in the city, the contract for furnishing the year's supply of coal had been awarded to Blackburn, Wallace and Co., at \$4.37 per ton, and that the requisite amount had been satisfactorily furnished.

Judge Draper then stated that this meeting had been called on account of a rebellion on the part of the janitors. Dr. Milne explained the way in which the trouble arose on Thanksgiving day when a little extra work became necessary on account of repairs to the steam-heating apparatus. On motion of ~~Mr.~~ Mr. Kim it was resolved that the present janitors be discharged and that the matter of procuring others be referred to a committee consisting of Judge Draper and Pres. Milne.

It was moved by Mr. Kim that Dr. Milne be authorized to arrange with Miss Clara Russell

to teach methods and act as critic in the Model School at a salary of nine hundred dollars per annum. carried.
