Some of your friends have called my attention to you as one who could give us considerable assistance on a matter in hand. We are occupied with the tremendous task of writing a "Handbook on National Socialist Germany". A number of the most prominent American scholars are cooperating with us in an effort to finish off our studies at the earliest possible moment.

Among the subjects which occupy a prominent place the subject of Nazi Education is of course one of the most important. You may, of course, depend on our having read most of the books on education. Most of them are of small use to us. What we need is a discussion as to the methods by which Nazis educate Nazis. Have you any materials that might be of use to us on this subject?
