

MINUTE BOOK OF LOCAL 157

FROM February 25 1937 TO 19

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE RECORDING SECRETARY.

The Recording Secretary of the Union is the officer who makes a record of all the transactions of the local union. He shall call the roll of the officers and note their absence. He shall at the opening of the meeting on instruction from the chair, read the minutes of the previous meeting. If approved, he shall so mark the minutes, requesting the presiding officer to put his signature to the minutes.

Then he shall keep a record of all the transactions that will be done at the meeting. He shall make a record of all votes and when demanded by the assembly he shall make note of the roll call vote, or of the "show-by-hand vote."

The Recording Secretary shall countersign all orders upon the Treasury, which orders shall also be signed by the President.

When the local union imposes a fine, or the chair imposes fines for disorderly conduct at the meeting, he shall make a record of same and give a copy of such a record to the Financial Secretary and Corresponding Secretary so that the fined member will be requested to pay the fine before regular dues from him are accepted. In the record of the minutes the Recording Secretary shall mention also the amount of money collected or the amount of money disbursed and balance on hand, as reports are made by the Financial Secretary and by the Treasurer. He shall furnish the General Secretary-Treasurer or other authorized officers with an authentic copy of the minutes of the meeting when so requested.

He may substitute the Financial Secretary or Corresponding Secretary in his absence, making a report of his work at the next meeting when the regular secretary will be in office.

The office of Recording Secretary in smaller local unions may be combined with the office of Corresponding Secretary.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CORRESPONDING SECRETARY.

The Corresponding Secretary of the Local Union shall have charge of the communications and the file of the Local. He shall answer all letters of General interest as per instructions of the Local and retain copy of the answer.

He shall send written advices of special meetings to members upon the request of the President of the Local, and for such purpose he shall have the address of every member of the Local.

At the request of the Financial Secretary he has to help him in communicating with the General Office regarding financial transactions.

In the absence of the Recording Secretary, he may be a substitute to that officer. In small Locals, the office of Recording Secretary and Corresponding Secretary may be held by the same person.

Read often the constitution of the International Hod Carriers', Building and Common Laborers' Union of America.
