Campus Progress Report No. 152

I am happy to report that the trench, housing high temperature hot water line which carries the heating from the Dutch Quad to the Indian Quad has now been completed and the trench has been back filled.

Yesterday the contractor black topped the area and restored the paving. Thus a worrisome problem has been solved. We were concerned about getting this stretch filled and until we did, it posed a safety hazard for students crossing from the Dutch Quad to the Academic Podium and Campus Center. This could have been particularly hazardous during the snow season. The hazard has now been removed.

A steeper stretch but less dangerous is located on the northeast corner where the accelerator is now being built. We are trying to get this road restored. The area has now been back filled and we have assurance that the road will at least be gravelled before more serious weather occurs. This will enable the Plant Maintenance Force to plow the road and will remove any hazard to the pedestrian.
