Replace Damaged Curbing and Resurface Perimeter Road

Today we made the final inspection on this project and accepted it without reservation. The job cost \$55,000 and accomplished the repair and replacement of curbing which was damaged when we had to hire outside plows to help us clear the campus during the bad winters several years ago. The resurfacing of Perimeter Road was also included and both of these aspects have been done in a highly satisfactory manner.

This final inspection was a culmination of certain corrective work which had not been satisfactorily accomplished and which was pointed up by the semi-final inspection earlier this past summer. All of these corrections have now been completed and these areas of our campus have not been in better shape in the past five years. Barring a similar catastrophe such as we experienced a few winters ago, we should reasonably expect to get another five to ten years service out of these facilities without requiring anything but minimal routine maintenance.

The job was accomplished by the Hudson River Construction Company, Albany, New York, and was completed on schedule.
