The minutes of the last meeting were read and
approved.

A draft of the Annual Report to the Regents
of the University and the Superintendent of
Public Instruction was read and after some
verbal amendment was adopted.

The Treasurer submitted a statement of
the condition of the finances of the School
from which it appears that the continual pay
ment to the Periodnl. Dr. Alden & to Prof. Cooty
of the extra compensation voted to them Dec. 23
1868 July 12, 1869 cannot be continued after
the present term, and the Treasurer was directed
to inform them to that effect.

The Secretary stated that Dr. Alden is of
opinion that a chap of Janitor seems exqui-
site. The Secretary was directed to inquire into
the matter, and was authorized to make such
arrangements in the premises as he shall
deem expedient, the salary of Janitor after
the present term not to exceed four hundred
dollars.

Conindable discussion was had on the
condition of the Model & Primary Department
and without reaching any conclusion
the Committee adjourned.
