

Monday, June 12, 1905. 3:30 P. M.

The meeting came to order promptly, in the office of the Commissioner of Education, Judge Draper in the chair, all members of the Committee present except Mr. Van Kessel, and Pres. Milne, by invitation.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

The finance committee submitted the report of report-accountant John Hourigan, of the examination which he had made of the Treasurer's accounts for the fiscal year ending July 31, 1904, finding them all correct. An motion the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Pres. Milne submitted a list of names of applicants for diplomas, duly recommended by the faculty and himself. An motion the diplomas were granted.

Pres. Milne presented the names of James H. Van Dickle, a graduate of this College and also of the University of Colorado, and Edward W. Wetmore, Professor in this College, for the degree of Doctor of Pedagogy. An motion both were granted.

At the suggestion of Pres. Milne one year's <sup>leave of</sup> absence, without pay, was granted to Prof. White to enable him to devote the time to study; and John M. Sayles, now Professor in the Lewis Falls High School, was employed to fill the vacancy, at a salary of \$1600.

An motion the annual salary of Prof. Aspinwall was increased from sixteen hundred dollars (\$1600.) to eighteen hundred (\$1800.).

An motion the letting of the contract for the supply of coal for the ensuing year was referred to the same committee as last year - the President of the College & the Treasurer.

An motion the Committee on Repairs was authorized to do what was found necessary during the summer.

An motion the Treasurer was instructed after July 31, 1905, to pay all tuition-fees collected by the President directly into the State Treasury on the first of each month.

An motion the meeting adjourned.

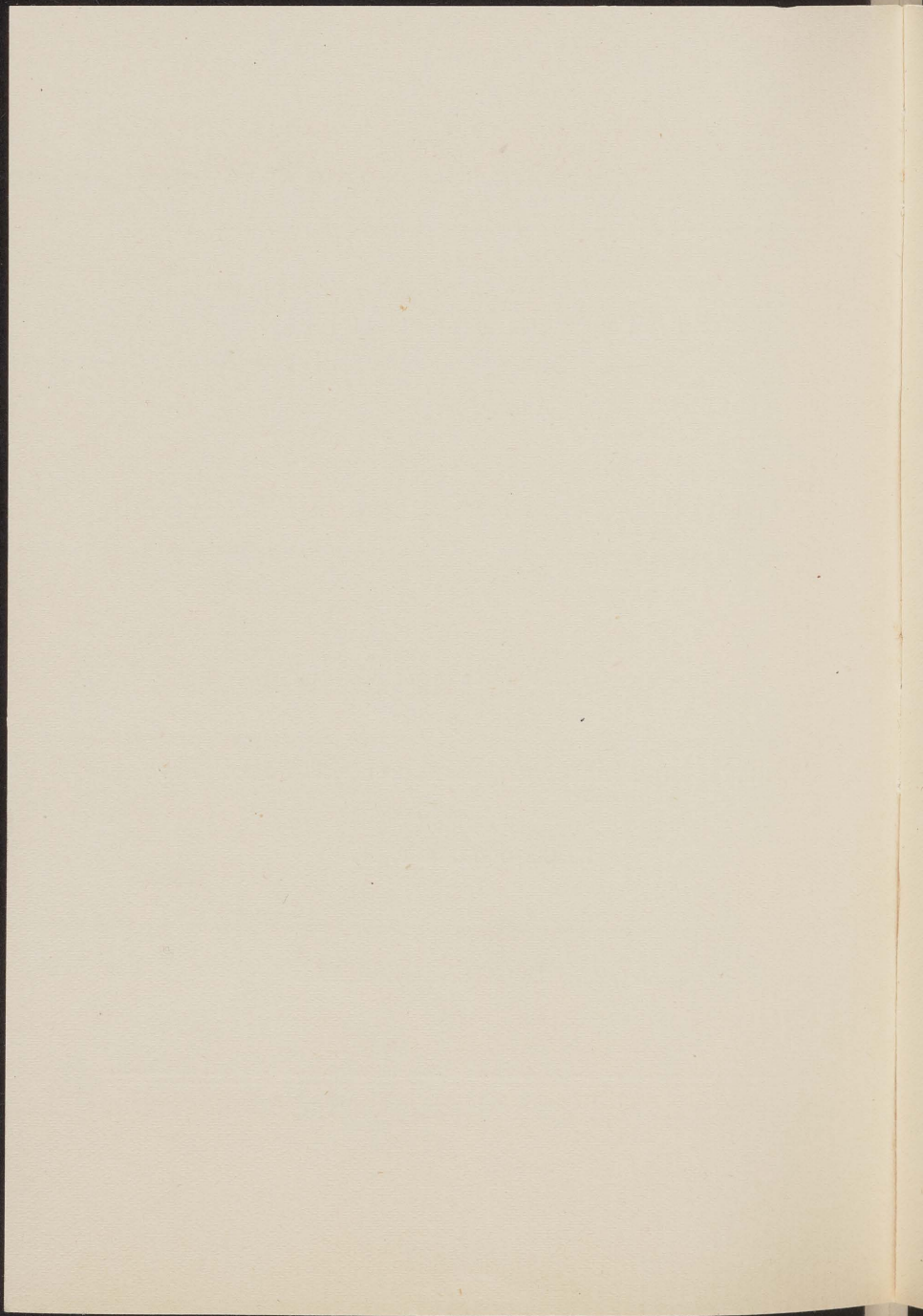
