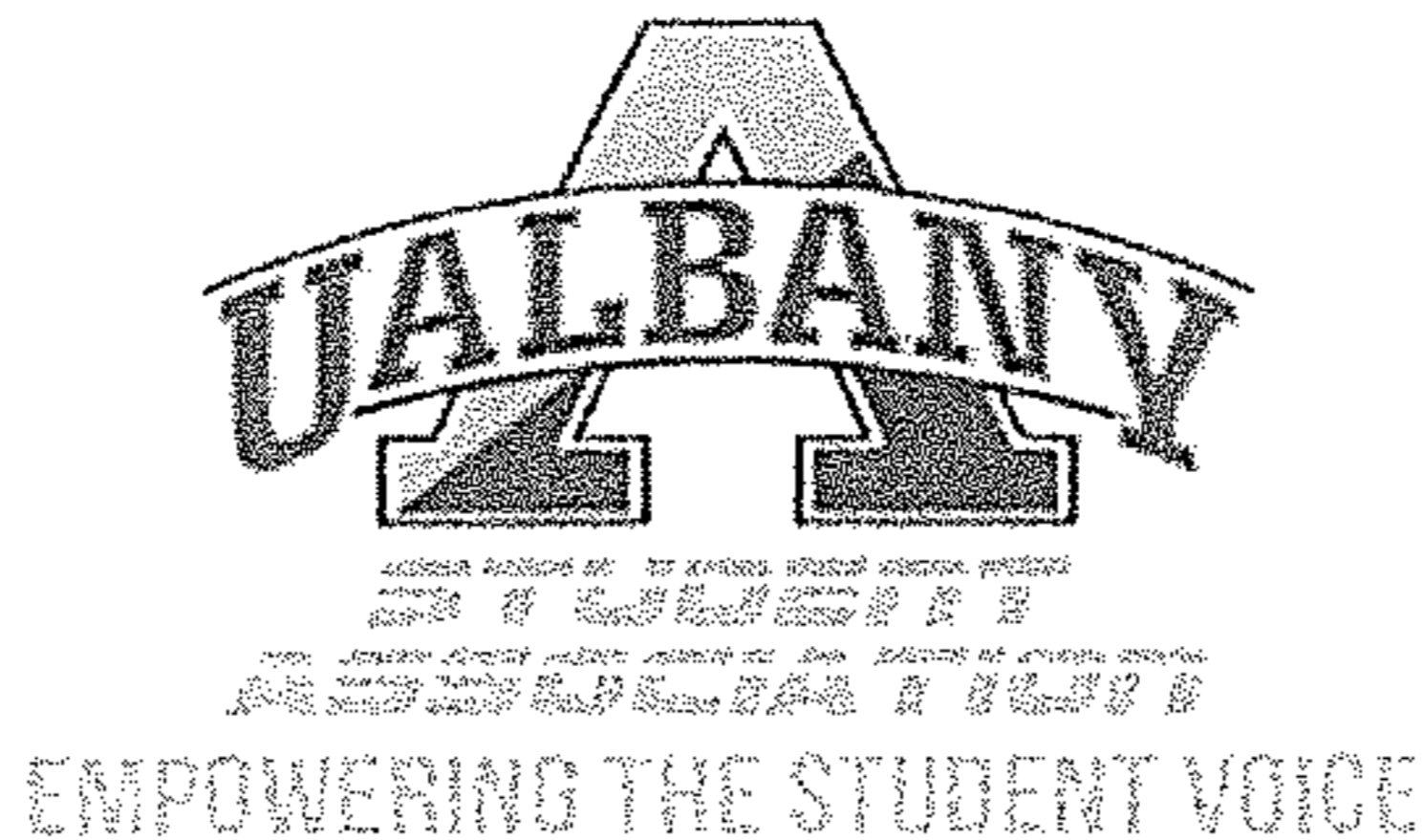

Be it hereby proposed that the following be enacted:


- I. WHEREAS, The University at Albany student parking lots provide weekly 24-hour parking to the University community; and
- II. WHEREAS, The largest parking lot is located by Dutch Quad, and the second largest is located by State Quad; and
- III. WHEREAS, A large portion of commuter students utilize Dutch and State Quad parking lots; and
- IV. WHEREAS, The other parking lots designated for students, Indian Quad and Colonial Quad, are much smaller and are usually filled with on-campus student vehicles; and
- V. WHEREAS, Due to the size and high usage of Dutch and State Quad parking lots, students often have a difficult time finding their vehicle; and
- VI. WHEREAS, Dutch and State lots don't have clearly labeled rows and columns creating confusion for students navigating the lots; and
- VII. WHEREAS, The only visible signs are signs that were donated by the class of 1986 located on the Dutch Quad parking lot, however, they are indistinguishable from each other because they are all labeled with the letter "A" and the color has been eroded away; and
- VIII. WHEREAS, There are no visible signs indicating parking sections on the State Quad parking lot; and
- IX. WHEREAS, Students have busy daily schedules and searching for their vehicle at different hours of the day causes undue time pressures and stresses; and
- X. WHEREAS, The structure of Dutch and State Quad parking lots do not provide easy and quick navigation to students searching for vehicle during the nighttime hours; and
- XI. WHEREAS, It is unsafe for students to spend a long duration of time searching for vehicles during the nighttime hours, and

- XIV. THEREFORE IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Office of Parking and Mass Transit Services and the Office of Campus Architecture, Engineering, and Construction Management will work cohesively towards the installation of visible, diversely labeled signs on the light posts on Dutch and State Quad parking lots; and
- XV.
