The committee resumed the consider-  
ation of the Model School.

After some time spent thereon,

It was resolved that Mrs. Monica B.  
<sup>a graduate of the twelfth term</sup> Kelly, be appointed Superintendent of  
the School under the direction of the  
President at a salary of one thousand  
dollars, and that Miss Ellen Bishop  
a graduate of the 62<sup>nd</sup> term be appointed  
assistant at a salary of \$600. it being  
understood that her services may be em-  
ployed in the Normal School when  
not required in the Model.

An appropriation having been made  
in the Supply bill of \$2500 for repairs of  
the building, including painting, draining,  
ventilation & furniture, Mr. Pinney  
was authorized to purchase a piano,  
paying any old ones to the treasuror,  
provided the same shall be approved  
by the Comptroller.

Mr. Pinney to the Secretary was ap-  
pointed a Committee to direct and  
superintend the repairs re. as author-  
ized in the appropriation.

Dr. Alden submitted a list of school  
books recommended by the Faculty  
for graduation which was approved.
