Today bids were opened on a contract for the Repair of Sidewalks at the downtown campus. Three bidders responded, the lowest of which was Callanan Industries of Albany, New York. His bid was \$30,387, well-within the previous cost estimate.

Accordingly, the Central Office has already directed OGS to place the contract, which should be done in a matter of a week or two. If all goes well, this job should be started this summer and possibly completed before the beginning of the Fall semester, or very shortly thereafter. We are attempting to accelerator the project as much as possible.

This will eliminate some safety hazards which exist in the irregularity of the sidewalks and which have given us some cause for concern for the safety of pedestrians.
