The committee met at the call of the Chairman,

The minutes of the last meeting were read & approved.

The secretary submitted a list of the members of the senior class of the school whom the Faculty recommend for graduation, which was approved.

It also stated that with the approval of individual members of the committee given to the President, Mr. F. J. Wilson had been employed as an assistant teacher for two weeks of the present term.

This was approved and the treasurer was authorized to pay him \$150 for his services.

The payment of mileage to certain scholars from parts of Green County, remote from the county seat, was considered and the treasurer was authorized to increase their mileage to a moderate amount at his discretion.

The matter of heating the building by steam and of replacing the existing seats by new and more comfortable ones was considered when it was resolved unanimously (Mr. Townsend having left by reason of a previous appointment) to apply to the Legislature for an appropriation of \$5000 for such purpose.

The committee then adjourned.
