Notice was received today, bearing a date of February 16, 1967 indicating that as of that date, title for Boyles and Pierce Halls, plus the intervening real estate on which these two Halls are located, has passed to the State, and from February 16 onward, we officially own these two buildings.

The 3.56¹/₂ acres on which these buildings stand now gives us uninterrupted property holdings extending all the way from Western Avenue to Kruecker, inclusive. This purchase did not include, however, the two houses on Ceteris Street which occupy lots No. 213 and 225. These are the lots which hold the white frame houses owned by N.Y.S. College for Teachers Benevolent Association. Although we had requested them be included, the purchase was consummated exclusive of these properties.
