The University Archives eventually began collecting news clippings that while not created by the university could potentially be of interest to future researchers interested in the University at Albany.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains newspaper clippings broadly related to The State University of New York at Albany, including construction projects, athletic events, notable speakers and noteworthy students, professors and alumni. Clippings come from a range of publications, ranging from local publications such as the Albany Times-Union to national papers including the New York Times. Clippings cover a period from roughly 1945 to 2002, with the bulk focused on the 1960s through the 1980s.
